On Sunday 22nd May, I came into work on my day off so that I could spend time planning activities for the upcoming week. I did this as I do not get any interruptions and the network seems to be faster on Sunday mornings.

Whilst working on my own in the surgery, I heard noises at the entrance, when I came out to see what was happening I saw these people taking drugs, as I took a video of them, they threatened me as they walked away.

The police class this as unthreatening anti-social behaviour. Therefore, when I reported it to them, even though I got threatened they did not come to the surgery.

Our Doctors generally like to come to the surgery to catch up on clinical paperwork over the weekend. However due to these people they do not feel safe coming to the surgery on their own, additionally the receptionist do not feel safe working extended hours in the weekdays or opening the surgery on the weekend for vaccination clinics.
